Sixty-seventh Annual General Body Meeting

The sixty-seventh Annual General Body Meeting of Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA) was held on November 01, 2021 via online mode. The event was graced with the presence of Hon'ble Vice President of India and President IIPA Shri M Venkaiah Naidu, Hon'ble Union Minister of State (I/C) of PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions,

Science & Technology, Earth Sciences, Space and Atomic Energy and Chairman of Executive Council of IIPA, Dr Jitendra Singh, Director General of IIPA, Shri Surendra Nath Tripathi, IAS (Retd.), Senior EC member Shri Shekhar Dutt, Former Governor of Chhatisgarh and Registrar IIPA Shri Amitabh Ranjan, among others. Presiding over the AGM through video conferencing, the Hon'ble Vice President of India said, "We are on a transformative path. We are focusing on people, their hopes and aspirations, their needs and entitlements, their duties and responsibilities. We are making each Indian an active agent of social change". Praising the efforts of IIPA, he added, "The Indian Institute of Public Administration, as a premier institution dedicated to the theory and practice of public administration, must, in my view, play a pivotal role in bridging the capacity gaps in the delivery system". He welcomed Union Minister, Dr Jitendra Singh, who took over as the Chairman of the Executive Council of IIPA recently. Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Jitendra Singh informed that the government will train Two crore government servants from top to bottom and not only the top civil servants for Capacity Building of Civil Servants. He further said, "first time since Independence, with the support of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, a revolutionary initiative has been taken to shift the working and functioning of the Civil Servants from 'Rule to Role', through the Government's most ambitious reform 'Mission Karmayogi', so that they are confident and able to perform the tasks assigned to them". The Minister added, "Indian Institute of Public Administration has established a Mission-Karmayogi Resource Cell at IIPA. Further, IIPA is working in close coordination with the Capacity Building Commission, LBSNAA and other central training institutions (CTIs). The Minister also informed that in a first of its kind and for more integration and coordination with branches, IIPA has started to conduct webinars on flagship schemes of Government of India in collaboration with regional branches from January 2021. He added that this step has proved to be beneficial, not only for IIPA but for the development of Regional branches also". The Minister said, "IIPA is also helping the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. of India in establishing and incubating National Tribal Research Institute (NTRI)". He further noted that despite the crippling effects of COVID-19, IIPA has not only being successful in conducting 66 online training programme in 2020-21 and trained 8353 officials, it has completed 60 research studies and conducted 46 webinars on topics of current relevance. He said, the 60 Research Studies completed in a year has been the highest in the history of IIPA in a single year and this includes a large number of Evaluation Studies of various schemes of Government of India for different Ministries and Departments also. The Director General of IIPA, Shri SN Tripathi announced the names of the winners of various awards and congratulated them. Shri Shekhar Dutt proposed the Words of thanks. Shri Amitabh Ranjan, Registrar IIPA along with the Dy. Registrar (AS), Shri Mithun Barua coordinated and organised the programme.
