The papers will be scrutinized by a committee of experts. Only those papers which are accepted for presentation will be circulated. However, synopses of all the papers will be circulated.

As already communicated, all Regional/Local Branches may organize prelude conferences on the theme preceding the Annual Conference. The Regional/Local Branches will make a presentation of synopses/summaries of reports of the regional conference during the Annual Conference.

Also, provide a list of relevant keywords that highlight the core concepts addressed in your paper. A brief biography about author in approximately 150-200 words may also be sent. The typed paper should have one-inch margin from each of the sides, 1.5 spacing and 'Times New Roman' (12 size) script. The paper should reach us (saketian@gmail.com) on or before September 5, 2023.

All papers will undergo a review process and accepted contributions will be published as part of this esteemed collection. This book is being complied for scholars, researchers, policy makers and students interested in philosophy, religion and Indian intellectual history.
