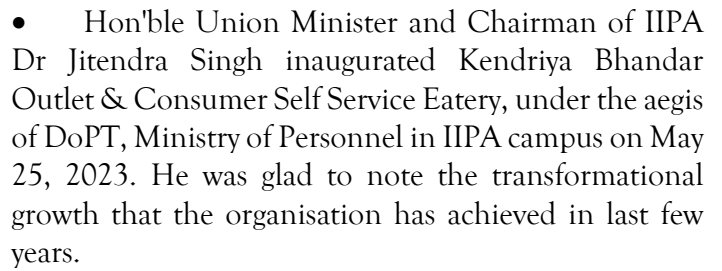

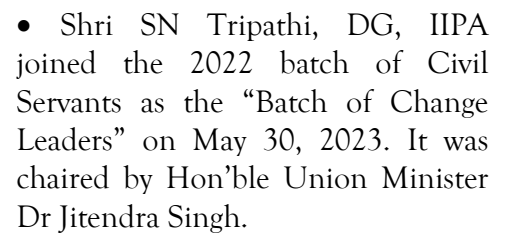

Also, provide a list of relevant keywords that highlight the core concepts addressed in your paper. A brief biography about author in approximately 150-200 words may also be sent. The typed paper should have one-inch margin from each of the sides, 1.5 spacing and 'Times New Roman' (12 size) script. The paper should reach us (saketian@gmail.com) on or before September 5, 2023.

All papers will undergo a review process and accepted contributions will be published as part of this esteemed collection. This book is being compiled for scholars, researchers, policy makers and students interested in philosophy, religion and Indian intellectual history.
