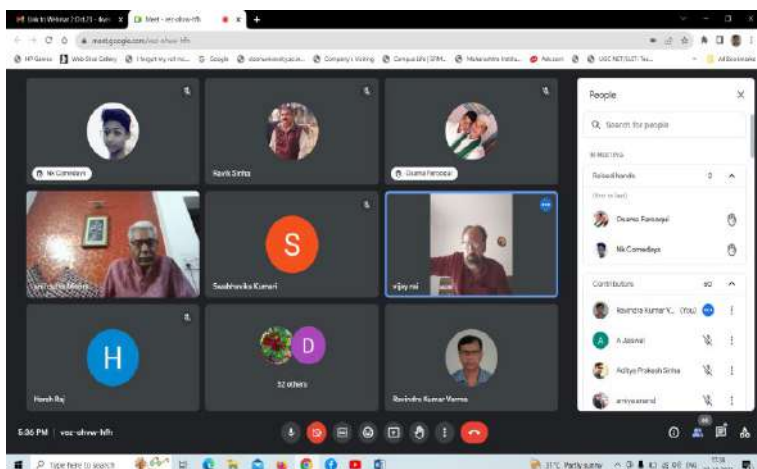

Cybersecurity and Data Privacy in the Indian Government: Protecting Digital Assets

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) of European Union provides a standard text for privacy legislations for many countries of the world. The various aspects of Cybersecurity and Data privacy are the following : (a) Cyberfraud prevention, (b) Digital public infrastructure, (c) Data localisation, (d) Digital currency and Blockchain security, (e) privacy legislation, (f) incident response plans, (g) international cooperation, (h) awareness and education, and (i) continuous monitoring and adaptation. Any legislation by the government of India must address the concerns arising from all these aspects, to cover all conceivable eventualities. It must also withstand any future practical and judicial scrutinies. Indian government has been seeking to enact such a law since 2006. However, Indian data consumers seem to be largely unaware of the significance of the privacy and dangers of indiscriminate personal data processing. Governments and private companies are driven and impacted by rapid digitisation, adoption of new technologies such as data analytics, artificial intelligence, automation of processes in profiling consumers. In this context there are two critical questions that must not be lost sight of : (a) Are the consumers' interests being protected adequately? and (b) are the data being used prudently restricted only to the purposes for which they are collected? To make the public aware of these issues, the government ought to intimate public awareness campaigns and help non-governmental organisations (NGOs) in this regard, especially in rural area. This should be included in school and college curriculas as well. Implementing the following steps is especially necessary and urgent: Identify the data subjects using their personal and organisational data and make them understand the privacy and related requirements for safeguarding the data, and upskill the existing talent and hire aides to focus on privacy implementation. We are now world leaders in the field belying our early scepticism about how India would adopt digital transformation as regards transferring money using Unified Payment Interface (UPI) or adopting e-governance, given our considerable rural population. But despite our initial handicaps, we will in all probability go ahead as the people of India seem to be realising the advantages safeguarding their personal data.

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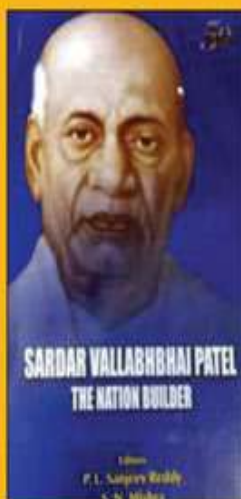
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
